

Environmental Principles

Marchment Hill's Environmental Principles create a framework within which we will seek to minimise the environmental impact of our operations. The framework identifies specific commitments to minimise our environmental footprint across electricity usage, waste, travel and procurement.

Our approach includes:

- Minimising the greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) emissions of the firm as far as practicable through lower use of energy and greater energy efficiency;
- Investigating carbon offsets or the purchase of renewable electricity to lessen our environmental footprint;
- Supporting staff in reducing their GHG emissions at home by providing access to knowledge, tools and services that may help them understand their personal carbon footprint and take action to reduce it;
- Minimising our use of paper and other consumables;
- Minimising the amount of waste going to landfill from our offices;
- Encouraging staff to recycle suitable waste material (paper, plastics, glass, metal, food scraps and toner cartridges);
- Exploring ways to minimise the extent of air-based travel as far as practicable, or purchasing carbon offsets for flights undertaken;
- Choosing office locations which are central to our clients and staff locations, to minimise travel;
- Utilising video and voice conferencing facilities as far as practicable;
- Seeking to source supplies with the highest environmental credentials; and
- Engaging with our suppliers to encourage them to source goods and services for their customers that are environmentally responsible.
